Re: GRAMA request to Utah School Boards Association dated 12/14/16

Dear Tracy:

I am following up on my prior letter relating to your December 14, 2016, GRAMA request to USBA. I have been asked to respond to your request.

As an initial matter, USBA does not believe that it is subject to GRAMA such that it is required to provide a response to your request. However, USBA is willing to respond to your request regardless of whether it is legally required to do so.

By way of general explanation, USBA does not typically retain materials related to its superintendent search services to member districts. Any documents and materials are generally retained only by the member district. USBA's responses to your numbered requests are as follows:

1. USBA does not have any responsive documents.
