EXTENDED DAY/DOUBLE SESSIONS

Extended Day Elementary

Extending the day is a cost saving measure that allows a district to put more students in the same existing space by either (1) increasing class sizes or (2) utilizing class space for an extended period of time during the day.

<u>Elementary school</u>: Elementary school extended day is usually done for the purpose of increasing class size, so the capacity of the school increases. This is a 15% increase in class size (3-4 students per class).

<u>Two tracks:</u> Class size increase is very unpopular with parents and teachers due to the lack of personalizing and connection that takes place with larger class sizes. To give student more individualized time during a portion of the reading instruction, students are put on a morning track or afternoon track.

Teacher contract: To compensate teachers for the extended day, their salary is increased by 15% to compensate teachers for large class sizes and working an hour extra each day.
